Subject:	Official Opening of Fiscal Year 2023 Comptroller Memo FY2023-05

Executive Summary

The Fiscal Year 2023 General Appropriation Act, Chapter 126 of the Acts of 2022, has been signed. This memo announces that July 28, 2022, is the official "opening date" of the accounting system. A deadline of August 12, 2022, has been established for the alignment of encumbrances and expenditures to the enacted budget.

The Fiscal Year 2023 General Appropriation Act has been signed. All accounts in all funds have been recorded in MMARS and expenditure ceilings have been adjusted to reflect 2/12^{ths} of the amount available for spending in all subsidiaries for all departments subject to the periodic allotment. This establishes legal authorization for Fiscal Year 2023 obligations and expenditures as of July 28, 2022. Therefore, the official "opening date" of the accounting system for Fiscal Year 2023 is July 28, 2022. Late penalty interest can be requested by vendors if bills have not been paid 45 days after the receipt of the invoice or 45 days after July 28, 2022, whichever is later, in accordance with 815 CMR 4.00 and the <u>Commonwealth Bill Payment Policy</u>.

Any accounting transactions that were processed under the House 2 revised structure must be recorded in conformance with the General Appropriation Act. Departments should complete any payroll and non-payroll adjustments to conform to the FY 2023 chart of accounts by August 12, 2022.

Departments may not request or accept performance, or otherwise incur obligations, in excess of department appropriations and allotments, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 29, §§ 26 and 27). Any reductions to expected spending levels for Fiscal Year 2023 budgetary accounts may require adjustments to previously executed contracts. The Office of the Comptroller's policy on

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Amendments, Suspensions or Terminations, located at <u>this link</u>, provides departments with the procedures for suspending, amending, or terminating contract actions as necessary to stay within their authorized spending limits. Departments are responsible for properly recording activity to the appropriate fiscal year, and other fiscal actions in accordance with state finance law.
