The purpose of this letter is to certify certain State Tax Revenue for Fiscal Year 2021. Attachment A presents the revenues by category on the official books of the Commonwealth. At a later date you may notice a variance in the amount reported for deeds tax revenue in the Commonwealth's statutory basis financial reports. This is the result of the use of accrual-based accounting in those reports. The figures in this certification do not include accrual.
