RE: March 2023 Certification of MBTA Base Sales Tax Revenues for Fiscal Year 2024

Dear Secretary Gorzkowicz and Secretary Fiandaca:

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 10, § 35T, this letter certifies for Fiscal Year 2024 the MBTA Base Sales Tax Revenue. This certification was done in consultation with the Department of Revenue. The details of the calculations are shown on the accompanying attachment.

Base Sales Tax Revenue: The base revenue amount for Fiscal Year 2024 is calculated by comparing the change in the calendar year 2022 consumer price index for all urban consumers for the Boston metropolitan area as determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor to the percent increase in gross sales tax revenues received pursuant to M.G.L. c. 64H and M.G.L. c. 64I for the same period. The calendar year 2022 "gross sales tax revenues" is defined as sales tax receipts by taxpayers from nonexempt sales, less amounts abated, refunded, or reimbursed. The attachment presents the calculation of the base revenue amount. The percentage increase in the base sales tax revenue is the lower of the percent increase in gross sales tax revenues or the inflation rate.

I certify to you that the base revenue amount for Fiscal Year 2024 increased by an amount of \$33,854,275, or 3.000% compared to the Fiscal Year 2023 figure of \$1,128,475,839. The base revenue amount for Fiscal Year 2024 is \$1,162,330,114.
